# What is Jakarta?

- Jakarta EE is the latest version of the Java Enterprise framework
- Java EE has been renamed to Jakarta EE
- Liferay DXP is moving to Jakarta EE from the2025.Q3 release



# Why is Liferay moving to Jakarta EE?

- Support latest Application Servers (Tomcat 10.1, JBoss EAP 8.0, Weblogic 15\*)
- Jakarta EE provides strong benefits including:
  - Enhanced features
  - Performance improvements
  - Updated security features
  - Better stability
  - Etc.
- JBoss EAP 7.x reached the end of Maintenance Support on June 30th



★ Weblogic 15 is expected later this year, but there is no confirmed release date yet

# What does this mean for you?

- Affects all customers upgrading to Liferay DXP
   2025.Q3 or later
- javax namespace has been renamed to jakarta
- All custom Java code which uses Java packages must be updated
- Dependencies and imports using javax namespace
   must be changed to jakarta namespace
- Third-party libraries used must also be Jakarta compatible
- App Server used by Liferay must be Jakarta EE compliant







## **Don't Panic!**

#### What this is NOT

- Liferay 6.2 > 7.0
- Changes to Liferay DXP functionality
- Liferay's own idea

#### What this IS

- A big search/replace (98% of DXP codebase was nothing more)
- Some code dependencies changes
- Alignment with the Enterprise Java industry and ecosystem



# What is Liferay doing?

- The Liferay DXP code has been fully converted to Jakarta
- Approx. 98% of this was just search/replace
- We're upgrading and migrating internal systems
- Our upgrades team is also working on upgrading some customer environments, including some with legacy versions
- And, we're introducing Jakarta-compatible supported versions of PortletMVC4Spring and JSF/Liferay Faces

# What Liferay is doing for you!

- Blade/Workspace tool to:
  - Convert custom code from javax to jakarta
  - Portlet 4.0 conversion
  - Leverage Liferay-specific conversion mapping
- **Eclipse Transformer** to:
  - Convert 3rd party library JARs from javax to jakarta
- Liferay **Database Upgrade** to:
  - Update javax references in DB tables (e.g. Freemarker)
